

NAME

`eh` — gives a survey of a file

SYNOPSIS

`eh [-lp] [file ...]`

DESCRIPTION

Eh gives a first impression of the contents of its arguments, which may be text files, object files, directories, etc. A usual call is

`eh *`

The **p**-option causes *eh* to search along **\$PATH** in shell-like fashion and handle all names thus matched. The **l**-option gives a long ls-like line for each file.
