

**NAME**

`lmr` — list most recent

**SYNOPSIS**

`lmr` [ `-N` | `-r` ] [ `dirname` ]

**DESCRIPTION**

A call of `lmr dirname` displays `ls -l` info of the *N* newest files in the directory *dirname* or in the working directory, if *dirname* is absent. The default value for *N* is 8.

The `-r` option causes information about the *N* oldest files to be displayed.
